



PRACTICE WOOD BLOCK

Bill of Material:

1 - 1 x 4 - 12" long

Construction Procedure:

1. Dress one edge of block.
2. Mark ends square to length and mark second side to width.
3. Saw off ends with hand saw. DO NOT PLANE.
4. Dress second edge using plane.
5. Mark out "V" notch.
6. Cut out "V" notch with crosscut handsaw.
7. Mark out hole.
8. Drill hole using carpenters brace and No. 8 auger bit.
9. Hand in with papers to be graded.
